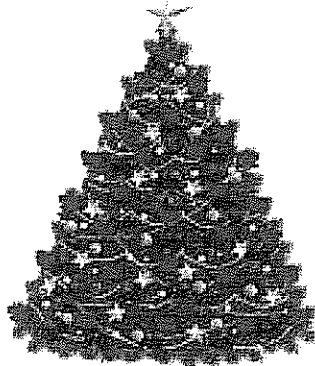

For those of you new to the school, these baskets are filled with items that you donate to each child's classroom basket. The baskets are then beautifully arranged and wrapped. Chances to win the basket are then sold to people throughout the day of the sale.

If you feel that you do not have the time or energy to shop, cash donations are appreciated (suggested donation of \$5 to \$10) and then used to buy items for the basket. Basket items or donations may be sent to school with your child and given to their teacher(s) or dropped off in the office with your child's name and or clearly marked on the donation. Checks may be made out to: Spirit of Christmas. Donations need to be turned in by Wednesday, October 28th to allow enough time for assembly and wrapping of the baskets.
